#### **Public Hearings**

Proposed 2024 Warrant Article to Amend the Wakefield Zoning Ordinance.

There was no Board discussion.

Mr. Fifield read the caption at the top of the warrant article. The Board was happy with the changes that were made.

Mr. Dube opened the Public Hearing at 7:04.

Mr. Kenney asked what came up to make changes to the ordinance. Mr. Dube said we had it as permitted with a conditional use permit and it was only in the table and there was no actual ordinance to go with the table. Mr. Kenney asked what the difference was between someone putting solar on their house and a solar energy system. Mr. Silcocks said that would be a farm for commercial use.

Mr. Kenney said that ground mounted systems are going away and being replaced with trackers. Mr. DesRoches said the ordinance covers it all and there will be a conceptual review. Mr. Kenney also asked how abandonment would work. The ordinance doesn't say what they would have to do. Mr. DesRoches said they would have to submit abandonment plans with their original application. It would be part of the site review and conditions could be added at that time. This way we could determine what applies to different sites.

Mr. Dube closed the Public Hearing at 7:10.

Mr. DesRoches made a motion, seconded by Mr. Silcocks, to move this ordinance on solar power to the ballot in March. (Vote 5-0)
