Minimum Impact Expedited Application for construction of additional retaining wall at 330 Beverly Hills Drive, East Wakefield, on Belleau Lake. Work was to be done under former, expired permit – now looking to have new permit issued so that the job can be finished. There being no quorum, the application cannot be signed. However, because it was submitted 1-12-10, these members elected to send the application on to the DES, with a list of issues that do not appear to be addressed by the application.
