

**Minutes of the Conservation Committee**

Alternative summer camps were discussed now that Barry Camp is closed. Tin Mountain Day Camp, Stone Mountain in Madison and several in Maine were discussed including Bryant Pond, 4 H in Lincolnville and Tanglewood in Camden, which costs only \$475 per camper for a one-week program. We're continuing to search for other camps.

Pride Day was discussed including the possibility it would be canceled this year.
