Old Business:

Pride Day – Mr. Day, Mr. Mankus, Mrs. Williams & Mrs. Chick have all indicated they will be able to man the Conservation Booth at Pride Day. Mrs. Williams will let Mr. Day know when the trees arrive so he can pick them up.

Camp –

1. Mrs. Farini confirmed that the parents' group has \$275.00 from last season's fund raising.
2. Mrs. Williams advised
  - a. There are 18 camp applicants as of Monday afternoon, and that parents have been advised there are no guarantees about who will be able to attend
  - b. Funds – PTA has offered financial assistance, but the amount will not be determined until the 6-14-10 PTA meeting. Mrs. Williams is planning on attending
  - c. Tanglewood has confirmed that between the camp weeks selected by our prospective campers, they have plenty of space
  - d. She will send the \$25/camper deposit for June 1; balance will be due before the beginning of camp. Mrs. Williams has established a July 15 cut off day for determining how many/who will be attending
  - e. For raffle
    1. Tickets will be sold at \$5/6 tickets
    2. Prizes – wall quilt, basket w/goodies, scratch tickets, gift cards from local merchants & tee shirts

With 18 prospective campers, at \$450/camper, total cost is \$8,100. Between deposits, parents' account and Conservation Commission, it appears that funds currently available are limited to \$2,325, leaving \$5,775 to be raised by parents through PTA, Pride Day raffle, and other sources.

No other subjects were discussed and meeting broke up at 8:35 PM.
