

TOWN CLERK POLICY

FOR NEW RESIDENT

Any person wishing to become a resident of Wakefield will need to show proof of residence.

To prove your residency you **must** provide at least two of the following.....

- A copy of a utility bill. This cannot be a cell phone bill. It needs to show mailing address and the location service is being received.
- A piece of mail (not junk mail) such as a bank statement, credit card bill or payroll.
- If you are renting a copy of the lease agreement would be appropriate.
- If you are living with someone you will need a notarized letter from them stating this fact.
- New construction must have Certificate of Occupancy

Once you register your car you will have 30 days to obtain a NH Driver's License.
