## **CALL TO ORDER**

1. Chairman Royle called the meeting to order at 7:00pm following the pledge of allegiance. Doug Stewart was seated for Tom Dube.

### PRELIMINARY DISCUSSIONS

- 3. John Williamson, representing he and his wife Linda Wickers Williamson came to the board to ask about what the possibility of developing their parcel known as TM 171-12. The 39-acre parcel lies on the shore of Horn Pond and apparently has access from both Donahue and Davis Roads.
- 4. Mr Williamson noted that the Davis Road end is currently gated and would likely require a wetland permit to create year-round vehicle access. Donahue Road would need widening and other improvements. Either upgrade would likely make either option expensive. The Williamson's need money to send their children to college. They do not wish to see the property developed and would like to have a structure on the property in the future.
- 5. N Smith noted that Horn Pond is the head waters to the Salmon Falls River, which would make it a prime location for a conservation easement. Information was exchanged so that Moose Mountain Regional Greenways could contact the Williamsons. Everyone agreed that exploring that option would work much better than any other type of development option.

The board generally liked the report and with a couple of minor revisions, should be ready for generate final drafts for the five lakes currently being studied. - 8. D DesRoches noted that AWWA is still looking for shoreland improvement projects to work on this summer.
