POLICY FOR USE OF COMPOST MATERIAL**

**1. Purpose**


The purpose of this policy is to establish basic rules for public use of the compost material located at the Wakefield Transfer Station.


**2. Policy**


When available, compost will be available at no charge to residents of Wakefield and Brookfield under the following conditions:

- A. Resident must display valid Wakefield Transfer Station permit on Transporting vehicle.
- B. Resident may transport, a maximum of, one standard size pick-up truck load per day (approximately 2 yards). Smaller amounts may also be transported.
- C. Resident must load compost material by hand using a shovel—no equipment to be used in loading; Transfer Station staff will not load compost material.
- D. Resident assumes any/all risk involved with loading and/or transporting compost material.
- E. Compost material is available for loading/pick-up by residents during regular operating hours of the Wakefield Transfer Station—Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. ***Compost material is NOT available for pick-up by residents when the facility is closed for any reason.***
- F. There will be no exceptions to the rules set forth in this policy.

Adopted by the Wakefield Board of Selectmen and effective as of <sup>July 11</sup> June 27, 2018.
